NO. 1 TENNESSEE LADY VOLS vs. NO. 16 AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS POST-GAME NOTES

NO. 1 SEED TENNESSEE LADY VOLS NOTES

- Redshirt sophomore Kelley Cain tallied her sixth career double-double with 18 points and a game-high 12 rebounds.
- Cain had six of Tennessee's eight points at the first media timeout.
- Tennessee opened the game on a 15-0 run and held Austin Peay without a field goal to the 13:14 point.
- Junior Angie Bjorklund was 4-of-12 from three-point range, it is the 23rd time in her career that she has made at least four threes in a game.
- The win extends Tennessee's overall winning streak to 15 games and its home winning streak to 18 games.
- Tennessee out-rebounded Austin Peay, 47-28, the 31st time this season UT has won the battle of the boards.
- Tennessee out-rebounded Austin Peay 26-8 in the second half.
- Tennessee never trailed in a game for the eighth time this season.
- Tennessee improved to 76-13 all-time in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 1 seed and has won 13 consecutive games as a No. 1 seed.
- All 10 Lady Vols played at least four minutes.
- Tennessee improved to 105-20 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

NO. 16 SEED AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS NOTES

- Austin Peay finished the season with a 15-18 overall record. The loss snapped a four-game winning streak by the Lady Govs.
- Austin Peay is now 0-7 in the NCAA Tournament. This was the sixth NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 10 seasons for the Lady Govs, all of which have come from the Ohio Valley Conference automatic bid.
- The last time Austin Peay played in the NCAA Tournament was the 2009 season when it was a No. 16 seed and lost to No. 1-seed Duke 83-42.
- This was Austin Peay's second trip to Knoxville, Tenn., for an NCAA Tournament appearance. The last time the Lady Govs played in Knoxville, they lost 80-38 in the first round of the 2001 Mideast Regional.
- Ashley Herring led the Lady Govs in scoring with 21 points as the only Austin Peay player to score in double figures. It was the 16th time this season Herring led the Lady Govs in scoring. Herring was 8-of-14 shooting, 2-of-3 from 3-point range.
- Jasmine Rayner scored eight points and collected six rebounds. Rayner came into the game having collected back-to-back double-doubles in the OVC Tournament. She had 20 points and 11 rebounds against Morehead State, and 12 points and 10 rebounds against Eastern Illinois.
- Nicole Jamen did not score for Austin Peay. She entered the game having collected three consecutive double-doubles.
- The loss drops Austin Peay's record against Tennessee to 0-6.
- The Lady Govs fell to 1-12 on the season when their opponent shoots a higher field-goal percentage. Austin Peay shot 30.2 percent in the game to Tennessee's 46.3 percent.
