

Hotels – Frequently Asked Questions – Pre-Season Pitching Camp

Are there any hotels near campus that have discount rates?

Yes, we have contracted with the Knoxville Marriott (about 1.2 miles from Campus) to reserve rooms for this camp. Campers can reserve a room for one or several nights at a reduced rate of \$75.

How do I get to the Clinic on Saturday Morning?

The clinic will be held in the Physical Education (HPR) building on the campus of the University of Tennessee, located in Knoxville, TN just off I-40 and I-75. For a map to the HPR Gym click on the following link:

The HPR Gym building is located just north of Tom Black Track at the intersection of Andy Holt Ave. and Pat Head Summitt St. The entrance to camp will be on the northern side of the HPR Gym along Andy Holt Ave.

When and where do we go to register?

Registration will begin at 8:15 am at the front entrance of the Physical Education (HPR) building. Please arrive well before the clinic begins at 9:00 a.m. The earlier you arrive the quicker you can be processed and admitted.

Parking

Unlike most of our other camps and clinics, This camp will take place while school is actively in session. As such, parking is a **MAJOR** concern. Please **DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION (HPR) BUILDING**. You will be quickly cited and/or towed. There are a large number of metered parking spaces that run the length of Volunteer Blvd. which are your best bet to avoid receiving a ticket. In addition, parking is available at the University Center Parking Garage.

What should I bring?

Pitchers should bring their glove and any additional equipment they use for a thorough pitching workout. Please make sure everything is clearly marked with your last name. Tennis shoes need to be worn - no cleats. There will be a one-hour lunch break where parents can take their kids to a large number of local restaurants or the camper can bring their own sack lunch.
